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Description of Services

Implementing the Curriculum

The following sessions may be taken consecutively (recommended) or separately, and/or combined with On-site Implementation Coaching days.

Introduction to *Open Up Resources 6-8 Math: Getting Started*

This session covers the format of lessons and key routines within lessons, including the “5 Practices” routine. Learning is through the lens of seeing, experiencing and discussing *Open Up Resources 6-8 Math* lessons. Information regarding key components and online resources is made explicit.

Introduction to *Open Up Resources 6-8 Math: Resources, Tips and Planning*

A second session covers additional online resources and encourages educators to examine more closely the overall scope and sequence and assessments of the curriculum. Participants receive tips and techniques for planning *Open Up Resources 6-8 Math* lessons and engage in a facilitated planning session.

Deeper Dive into *Open Up Resources 6-8 Math*

This session is designed for teachers with at least one year of experience teaching *Open Up Resources 6-8 Math*. The 1-2 days of learning are tailored to teacher needs based on identified challenges and successes with implementing *Open Up Resources 6-8 Math*. Participants will address implementation issues, learn and plan use of specific supports and routines, and refine instruction through a problem-solving approach and utilizing supports to address the needs of all students.

Ongoing Coaching

On-site Implementation Coaching

This service provides highly relevant, job-embedded professional learning that meets teachers where they are and moves them forward with effective implementation and instruction through lesson modeling and mentoring. CORE also will work with instructional leaders and administrators to develop solutions to implementation challenges and nurture best practices in teacher coaching to ensure long-term implementation success.

Personalized Virtual Coaching

These 60-90 minute live virtual coaching sessions are designed for up to 20 teachers and/or instructional leaders implementing *Open Up Resources 6-8 Math* (smaller group sizes of 5-10 are preferred). In these sessions, the CORE consultant addresses an identified area of need, such as specific program routines, use and/or analysis of assessments, planning specific lessons or a unit, or understanding specific content and pedagogy. The CORE consultant can also use these sessions to mentor instructional leaders to build local capacity to sustain improvements.

Support for Instructional Leaders

Leadership Learning Walks

Provide a model and support for leadership learning walks designed for administrators and teacher leaders. A CORE consultant will provide instructional leaders with an overview of *Open Up Resources 6-8 Math* along with an observation protocol that focuses on critical features of program content and delivery. The consultant will lead focused discussions with instructional leaders based on an analysis of visits to selected classrooms to monitor program implementation. The consultant will support site leadership so they have the knowledge, tools and confidence to lead sustained math improvement efforts.

How Do These Services Fit Together?

Support services are designed to break *Open Up Resources 6-8 Math* implementation into manageable steps.

Implementing the Curriculum is your starting point. Our implementation sequence begins with two one-day courses (which can be taken individually or consecutively) before or in combination with moving to on-site implementation to ensure instruction takes hold.

Deeper Dive is designed for those with at least one year of experience with *Open Up Resources 6-8 Math* and provides support to deepen understanding of instructional routines and address challenges of implementation.

Ongoing Coaching supports classroom implementation. Virtual coaching also is available to provide personalized coaching for small groups to address identified needs.

Support for Instructional Leaders provides knowledge of what to look for in classrooms and how to identify areas of need for teachers to ensure ongoing success with the curriculum.
