



Language


- It is completely possible to learn how to read, write and speak in two languages at the same time.

- It has to be explicitly taught






House of Literacy







Scarborough's Reading Rope





- Routine
- Corrective Feedback



Key Teaching Practices

- Systematic and explicit and mastery oriented
- Cumulative
- Highly interactive
- Targeted prompt feedback
- Data-based and diagnostic






Implication for Instructional Organization


- Small group, skill-based groups FROM THE START
- Mastery oriented
- Based on diagnostic screening/placement





The language teacher in you will...

- Understand that every lesson is based on language
- Create scenarios based on effective instruction that allows students to have speaking practice
- Be thoughtful about grammar



The reading teacher in you will...

- Think about the five strands and infusing language opportunities
- Understand that heritage language is made of sounds and make connections to phonemic awareness in heritage language and English
- Encourage parents to read/speak with students in heritage language at home




